UNDERSTANDING OUR PRESENT AGE Toward 2030

ON MARCH 21, 2022, two years after the 2020 Pandemic started, President Biden articulated what is now, without question, a new world order reshaping our nations. He Said, "Now is a time when things are shifting. There's going to be a new world order out there, and we've got to lead it. And we've got to unite the rest of the free world in doing it."

Anyone who has read my books¹ know that I believe America, along with Great Britain, establishes the agenda and leads the world to put into place the infrastructure necessary for the one called the Antichrist to be given power. The fact that President Biden acknowledges the new world order, and that America needs to take the lead, reveals that the new world order is very much political reality and is being advanced by the nations.

The United Nations and Agenda 2030

The 2020 Pandemic gave the United Nation's and its partner, the World Economic Forum, the opportunity to put into high gear the final events to establish the new world order through the United Nation's Agenda 2030. Its goal is to finalize the transformation of national economies, culture, and the realignment of all nations under international governance. To get there, national economies must become cashless and contactless, the Judeo/Christian standards must be overturned, and national sovereignty must be replaced with submission to international governance. Though we have been moving in this direction for many decades, actually since the founding of America, the 2020 Pandemic not only brought to the world's consciousness, but also accelerated the economic, political, and cultural infrastructures to make the 2030 goal achievable. The result has been economic breakdowns, cultural upheavals, and the cry for international governance. Until the 2030 goal is achieved, from this point forward, the economic, cultural, and political breakdowns will only increase until the new world order is in place and the world as we know it is completely transformed. From a Biblical Perspective

The United Nation's agenda fits perfectly with the Biblical timeline for the arrival of the one called the Antichrist. Keep in mind that the Bible tells us what will take place, and world events give the details of how they take place. According to the Bible, a world leader (the Antichrist) will arrive after certain empires have risen and fallen, the infrastructure for a cashless economy is

in place, and the world's culture has gotten much worse, reaching a depravity that the Apostle Paul calls "perilous" (2 Timothy 3:1).

It was Daniel the prophet who revealed the empires that would rise and fall. These empires were identified in Daniel 2 and 7 as Babylon, Mede/Persia, Grecian, Roman, Divided Roman, Great Britain, United States, Russia, Islam, and a final global empire. Eight of these empires have risen and fallen from their height of glory. The United States is in its final phase of crumbling in preparation for the new world order, and the final global empire is currently being put into place. In preparation for the new world order, the infrastructure for a global, cashless economy must be in place and the nations cultures must be in shambles. The prophet Daniel revealed the nations that would rise up to lead us to the final global empire. It was Jesus who revealed, in Matthew 24, the cultural shifts and increase in natural disasters. In this chapter Jesus teaches that the thinking and beliefs will change from a Judeo/Christian perspective to a worldly perspective when he taught to guard ourselves against deception and teachers and philosophies and beliefs and practices contrary to God (Matthew 24:4-5, 11, 23-24).

Jesus also taught that...

- Wars and rumors of war will be everyday occurrences
- Racial and ethnic tensions and wars will only increase and intensify
- Disease will continue to be more frequent and more deadly
- Earthquakes will be more intense, more frequent, and more destructive
- People will turn violent against each other: family members, neighbors, co-workers, strangers
- Wickedness, immorality, violence, depravity will become the norm
- Persecution of those holding Judeo/Christian values and not in support of the new norms

The good news is that the gospel will be preached during these difficult times, even though it won't be received by the majority. From our present age forward, the darkness will increase and the light of the gospel and Christ will grow dimmer. In season or out of season we must be about the Father's business of declaring the need for repentance.

This will be the condition of the nations prior to the arrival of the Antichrist. Note that what Jesus taught will increase is contrary to the United Nation's Agenda 2030, which outlines the elimination of these issues that Jesus said would be more frequent and intense. Through their benevolent, worldly goals the United Nations will deceive many. The problem is the United Nation's goals goes against the revealed word of God. Therefore, Agenda 2030 will not achieve the elimination of poverty, disease, racism, etc.. The issues the world faces will only become more intense and more frequent until the cashless economy and the realignment of all nations under global governance is in place—and then all hell breaks loose.

All Hell Breaks Loose

Once the United Nations reaches its 2030 goals, which they are on track to accomplish, Judeo/Christian standards will have been overturned and chaos and violence and all types of

depravity will be the norm. It is in this environment that the one called the Antichrist will be given authority over the new world order. He will be seen as one who will fix the world's economies, and for three and a half years his policies will cause the nation's economies to prosper (Daniel 8:25). He will also bring peace to Israel and her neighbors (Daniel 9:27). In this way he will draw many well-meaning, but deceived, people to his side. Keep in mind that Adam and Eve were deceived by the benefits they perceived, and so will many of you be deceived when you see the prosperity and peace that is coming to Israel. Be on guard. Don't be deceived. Understand the prophetic times and hold tight. It was Jesus who taught there is no excuse for not knowing where we are on the prophetic timeline when he stated after teaching on the last days, "Behold, I have told you before" (Matthew 24:25) He even reprimanded those who could not discern the signs of the times for their generation: "O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?" (Matthew 16:3)

After the three and a half years of peace and prosperity, then all hell breaks loose. What is known as the great tribulation takes place. Anyone who does not submit to the Antichrist's cashless, Christless new world order are considered enemies. He makes war with the nations not in agreement with him and seeks to kill all of God's people. This is where Agenda 2030 is leading us. It is setting in place the final pieces necessary to give leadership to the Antichrist. Essentially the entire world is working toward a great reset of national economies, their cultures, and national sovereignty to establish the new world order.

From a Biblical perspective this movement toward a new world order no later than 2030 parallels perfectly the timeline set for the one called the Antichrist to appear. In fact, when Agenda 2030 is achieved, a cashless infrastructure for buying and selling will be firmly in place to replace our current cash-based economies. Also, the cultural shift from a Judeo/Christian value system will have been complete and those with a strong Judeo/Christian mindset will be seen as hindrances to and enemies of the new world order. The third main shift is our shift from national dependence to global governance. These are the final events necessary for the Antichrist to be given authority over this new ordering of the nations. Once in place, the Antichrist will arrive soon after. Considering how quickly Agenda 2030 is advancing, the Antichrist could be on the scene as early as, if not before, 2030, less than eight short years away. Let that sink in. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil

not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, "What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?" (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knows that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for tomorrow: for tomorrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof."
